In 2013, Perdue Farms completed the remodel of its Corporate Offices and earned the Leadership Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Platinum certification, the highest rating awarded by the U.S. Green Building Council. At the time, Perdue was the first LEED Platinum commercial project on Maryland's Eastern Shore.
