

Scott Fredericksen President, Perdue AgriBusiness

Scott Fredericksen is President of Perdue AgriBusiness LLC, one of two independent operating divisions of Perdue Farms and among the largest U.S. grain companies. He joined the company in 2019.

Fredericksen oversees a diverse group of agricultural businesses in the domestic and international food, feed, agricultural inputs and biofuels industries.

Perdue AgriBusiness sources, purchases and processes agricultural commodities from more than 8,000 farmers and offers a diverse portfolio of products, including grains, soybean meal, blended feed ingredients, organic and speciality seeds and top-quality oils for the food services from information including accounting, risk management and industry, and logistics management, to information technology.

Prior to joining Perdue AgriBusiness, Fredericksen had a long career with ADM (Archer Daniels Midland

Co.) beginning with soybean crushing operations in the early 1980s. From 1998 to 2016, he held various key management positions: vice president of North American Oilseeds, president of the Specialty Food Ingredients Division, president of North America Oilseed Crushing Division, and president of Global Transportation. In 2016, Scott became the geographic president of ADM South America and joined the ADM Executive Committee helping to guide overall company strategies.

Fredericksen is a graduate of Minnesota State University, Mankato, with a bachelor's degree in international business and marketing, and the Harvard Business School Executive Education CEO led Executive Business Program.
