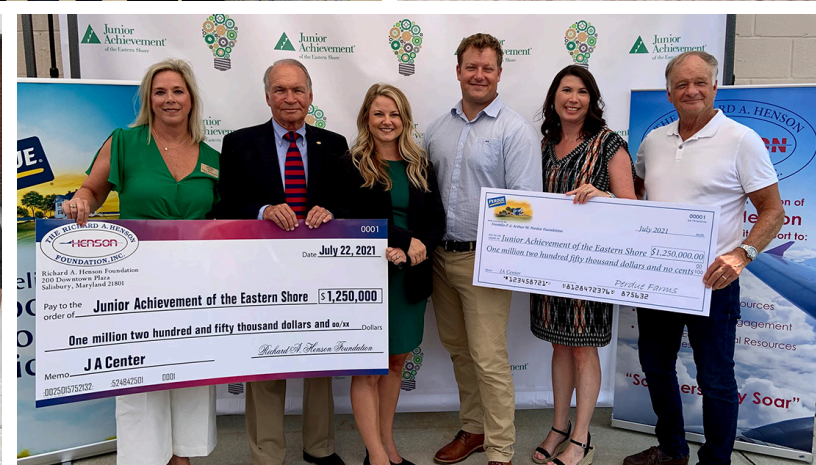
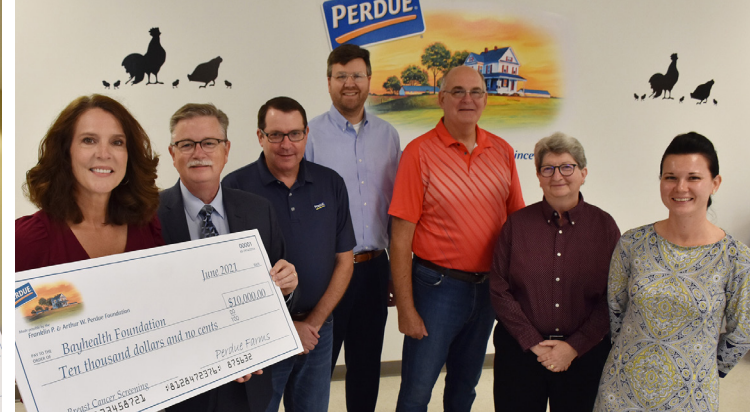

While the footprint of the company grows with mergers and acquisitions across the country and into Canada, so does the reach of the Foundation. Our commitment to all of the communities Perdue calls home remains as strong and steady as ever. Additionally, the Perdue Family continues its legacy of generosity to honor Frank and Arthur Perdue. There were 218 grants awarded, totaling \$3,039,727. Some awards and activities worthy of highlight were:

- Some \$403,000 was awarded to organizations focusing on education and literacy to improve the lives of our neighbors.
- Feeding those in need and helping to fight poverty is always one of the primary focuses of our Foundation. This year over \$200,000 was awarded to 15 organizations that are working to address these issues for our neighbors in need.
- Public safety and community improvement projects have been a long-standing priority of the Perdue Foundation. Our founders, Arthur and Frank Perdue, believed in the value of volunteer fire departments and we remain dedicated to their legacy of giving to these and other important community assets. In 2021, \$297,000 was contributed to projects and programs that protect and enrich the lives of our friends and neighbors throughout the footprint of our company.

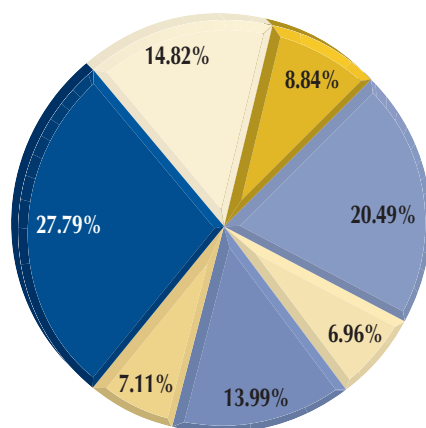

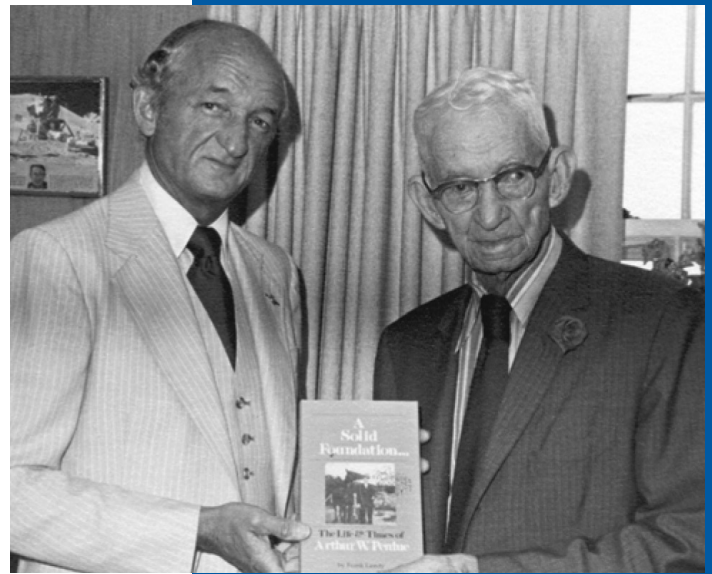
